- You are available to attend every Senate Meeting (Thursdays from 7 PM to about 8:30 PM).

- **Senate Candidate Debate**
Tuesday, February 3, 2015 from 6 to 8 PM – *Location To Be Announced*

SUBMISSION DEADLINE – JANUARY 30, 2015 at 5 PM

- After completing your Senate Candidate Application and Signature Petition (25 signatures), you must submit both documents *in-person* to the ASLC Office in Templeton Campus Center (Rm. 238) no later than 5 PM on Friday, January 30, 2015.
- In addition, you must submit your Candidate Statement & Photo via email to elections@lclark.edu no later than 5 PM on Friday, January 30, 2015.
