Senate Resolution Number FA18 SR001

A Resolution to Reject the Confirmation of Brett Kavanaugh to the United States Supreme Court

Whereas, on October 6th 2018, Brett Kavanaugh was confirmed and sworn in to the United States Supreme Court,

Whereas, Brett Kavanaugh has been accused by three women of sexual assault or misconduct with such survivors being Christine Blasey Ford, Deborah Ramirez, and Julie Swetnick,

Whereas, these allegations of sexual misconduct span back to the 1980s when Brett Kavanaugh was in high school,

Whereas, two of his accusers report that Brett Kavanaugh attended house parties in high school where women were sexually harassed, drugged, and “gang raped” and that he participated in this behavior,

Whereas, Christine Blasey Ford reported that Brett Kavanaugh pinned her to a bed and tried to remove her clothing stating that, “I thought he might inadvertently kill me”,

Whereas, “Only about 2% of all rape and related sex charges are determined to be false, the same percentage as for other felonies (FBI),” according to Stanford's report of common misconceptions about abuse,

Be it resolved by the Senate of the Associated Students here assembled that we stand with and believe Christine Blasey Ford, Deborah Ramirez, and Julie Swetnick, sexual assault survivors of Brett Kavanaugh.

Be it further resolved by the Senate of the Associated Students here assembled that a perpetrator of sexual assault cannot serve on the United States Supreme Court.

Be it lastly resolved by the Senate of the Associated Students here assembled that we do not support Brett Kavanaugh’s confirmation to the United States Supreme Court.
