



Mid-Year Senate Application

The Student Senate of the Associated Students of Lewis & Clark (ASLC) is an institution designed to represent your and your classmates' needs and interests here at Lewis & Clark. Twelve student-elected Senators represent the entire school, and there is currently **one vacancy** in the Senate.

A Senator's job includes discussing and writing legislation with fellow student leaders and working in tandem with the ASLC Cabinet to promote the interests of the student body. Senators are required to attend one Senate meeting per week and are expected to serve ASLC by being a member of at least one of ASLC's standing or ad hoc committees.

You are qualified to be a Senator if:

- You can work with your fellow Senators to learn what the student body wants to be accomplished.
- You can actively listen to your classmates and vote to represent their interests in Student Senate.
- You are in good academic standing.
- You obtain twenty-five (25) student signatures.
- **You are available to attend every Senate meeting (on Thursdays at 7pm).**
